ORDER


Sub: Implementation of Actions under Stage-III ('Severe' air quality) of revised GRAP in Delhi NCR steps to be taken.

The Sub- Committee for operationalisation of the revised GRAP has reviewed the air quality scenario as well as the forecasts for meteorological conditions and air quality index in Delhi. The Sub-Committee vide order No.120017/27/GRAP/2021/CAQM dated 4th December, 2022 has invoked all the actions as envisaged under **Stage-III** of the GRAP- 'Severe' Air Quality (Delhi AQI ranging between 401-450), with immediate effect in the NCR, with immediate effect, in addition to all the actions under Stage-I and Stage-II of the GRAP.

As per the directions as provided under Stage III of the revised GRAP and under section 115 of Motor Vehicle Act, 1988, it is hereby ordered that there shall be restrictions to ply BS- III, Petrol and BS- IV, Diesel LMVs (4 wheelers) in NCT of Delhi, with immediate effect, till dated 09/12/22 or till downward revision in GRAP stage, whichever is earlier. (Except for vehicles deployed in Emergency Services, Government/Election work)

If any BS- III, Petrol and BS- IV, Diesel LMV (4 wheeler) found plying on the roads will be prosecuted under section 194 of Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 which provides with a fine of Rs. 20,000/-.

This issue with the prior approval of the Competent Authority.
